

APPLICATION FORM FOR PARALYMPICS NEW ZEALAND CLASSIFICATION ID CARD



Achieving is Believing.

As more and more athletes with a disability are competing in able-bodied competition a number of technical issues have been identified. For it to be possible for officials to identify the exception to the rules for the various disabilities and so that the athlete is not disqualified for a technique that is not possible, Paralympics New Zealand is issuing athletes with a disability with an official classification identification card.

The ID Card will be required to be presented to the meet manager/referee when competing in able-bodied competitions. In this way the rule exceptions will be observed by the officials at the relevant competitions. Athletes not holding an ID Card will be required to compete under the able bodied rules. Consequently, it is in the interests of all athletes with a disability to present their card at **every** competition they are competing at.

The ID Card will identify that you

- i. Maintain an authorized classification.
- ii. Have the necessary exception to the rules when competing.
- iii. Are eligible for any records you may set in your class.
